COVID-19 Visitor Guidelines

The love and support of family and friends can be very important to the healing process. At this time, however, risks associated with COVID-19 require that visitation be limited.

Two visitors per resident visit is permitted for all residents with few exceptions:

Current visitor hours: Sunday—Saturday starting at 11:15 a.m. through 6 p.m. (These hours are subject to change).

Please note that the facility may have additional constraints or requirements beyond these guidelines, based on the need to maintain patient and staff health and safety. Patients, caregivers, and visitors should contact Resident Services with any questions.

VIRTUAL VISITS: Residents who would benefit from additional support during a visit or stay should request the use of technology to bring important family and friends virtually into the facility.

CHECK IN: Everyone—patients, caregivers, and visitors—is required to stop at the check-in desk located at the front entrance of the building for a COVID-19 Screening.

- All are expected to arrive wearing a mask or face covering. Those who do not have a mask will be provided one. All masks must be worn for the entire duration of the visit. Those who do not comply will be asked to leave the premises.
- Caregivers and visitors with symptoms of any kind and those who have had contact with someone positive for or suspected of having COVID-19 are not permitted at this time.
- Everyone is expected to sanitize their hands upon arrival and exit from the outdoor visit.
- Visitors will have COVID-19 screening and must provide their negative COVID-19 test result prior to visit. The negative COVID-19 test must have been conducted within 7 days of visit.
- Following Screening, visitors will be escorted to a designated visitation area.
- All visits are supervised at all times and visitors are to remain wearing their masks and maintain a 6 ft.
 distance from the resident at all times.
- No more than two visitors at a time one of which must be 18 years or older.
